Camping averages \$20 for electric/water and \$15 for primitive. We will be collecting camping fees under the pavilion both Fri. & Sat. Day trippers welcome!! Directions to the Ranch: Exit 293 off of I-75. Left (east) on County Road 41. Go 1.5 miles then make left on Clay Hill Road which turns into Myers Road - 1.8 miles. Make left into Sertoma Youth after white picket fence. Very dog friendly but please keep on a leash.
